A. Abraham's Faith is \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 21:1-34**

1. Abraham trusts the LORD for a \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 21:1-7**

**Genesis 21:1–2** - The LORD visited Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did to Sarah as he had promised. <sup>2</sup> And Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age at the time of which God had spoken to him.

2. Abraham trusts the LORD for \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 21:8-21**

**Genesis 21:12–13** - But God said to Abraham, “Be not displeased because of the boy and because of your slave woman. Whatever Sarah says to you, do as she tells you, for through Isaac shall your offspring be named. <sup>13</sup> And I will make a nation of the son of the slave woman also, because he is your offspring.”

3. Abraham trusts the LORD for \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 21:22-34**

**Genesis 21:22–24** - At that time Abimelech and Phicol the commander of his army said to Abraham, “God is with you in all that you do. <sup>23</sup> Now therefore swear to me here by God that you will not deal falsely with me or with my descendants or with my posterity, but as I have dealt kindly with you, so you will deal with me and with the land where you have sojourned.” <sup>24</sup> And Abraham said, “I will swear.”

B. Abraham's Faith is \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 22:1-24**

1. Complete \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 22:1-3**

**Genesis 22:1–2** - After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, “Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.” <sup>2</sup> He said, “Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.”

2. Complete \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 22:4-8**

**Genesis 22:4–5** - On the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes and saw the place from afar. <sup>5</sup> Then Abraham said to his young men, “Stay here with the donkey; I and the boy will go over there and worship and come again to you.”

3. Complete \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 22:9-14**

**Genesis 22:6–7** - And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son. And he took in his hand the fire and the knife. So they went both of them together. <sup>7</sup> And Isaac said to his father Abraham, “My father!” And he said, “Here I am, my son.” He said, “Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?”

4. Complete \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 22:15-24**

**Genesis 22:16–18** - And said, “By myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, <sup>17</sup> I will surely bless you, and I will surely multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore. And your offspring shall possess the gate of his enemies, <sup>18</sup> and in your offspring shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice.”

C. Abraham's Faith is \_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 23:1-20**

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Sarah - **Genesis 23:1-2**

**Genesis 22:1–2** - *After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, “Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.”* <sup>2</sup> *He said, “Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.”*

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ for Sarah – **Genesis 23:3-18**

**Genesis 23:4, 8-9** - *“I am a sojourner and foreigner among you; give me property among you for a burying place, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.”* ...<sup>8</sup> *And he said to them, “If you are willing that I should bury my dead out of my sight, hear me and entreat for me Ephron the son of Zohar,<sup>9</sup> that he may give me the cave of Machpelah, which he owns; it is at the end of his field. For the full price let him give it to me in your presence as property for a burying place.”*

3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Sarah – **Genesis 23:19-20**

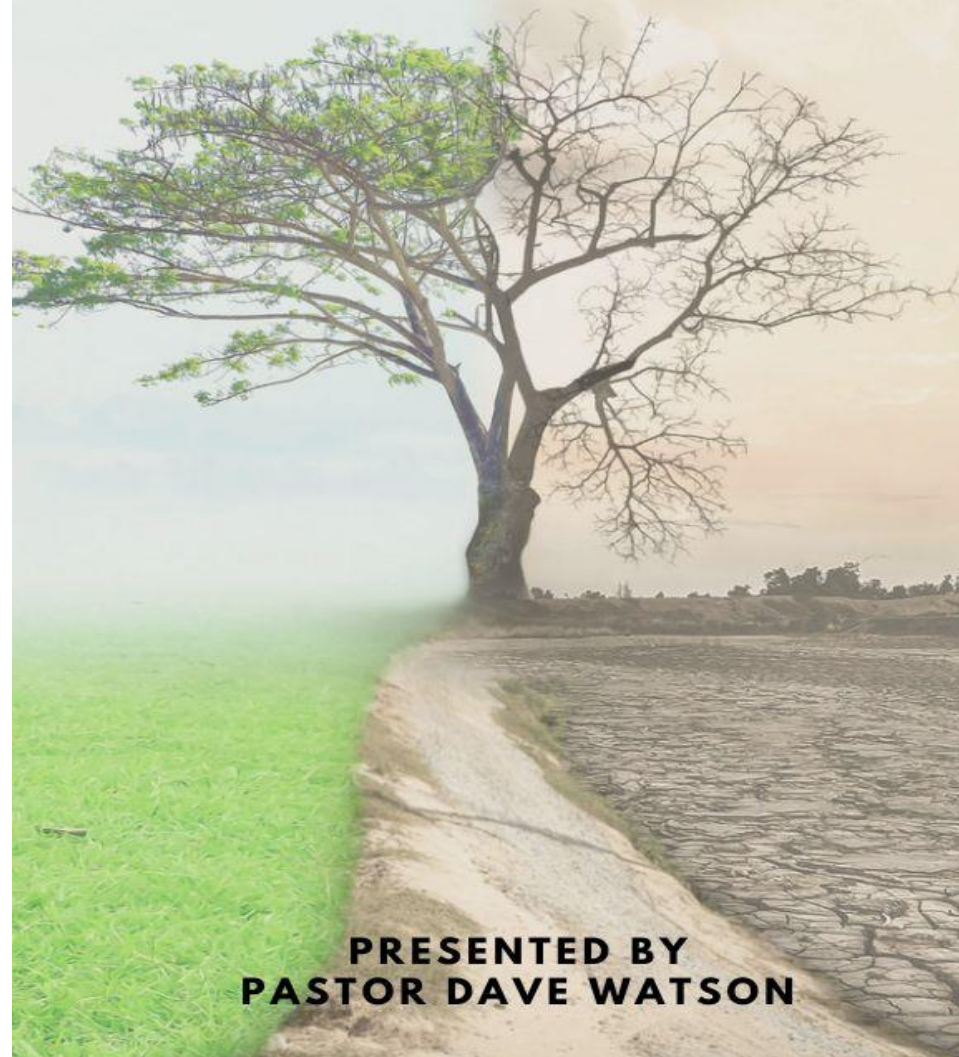
**Genesis 23:19–20** - *After this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah east of Mamre (that is, Hebron) in the land of Canaan.* <sup>20</sup> *The field and the cave that is in it were made over to Abraham as property for a burying place by the Hittites.*
