B. The Second Bowl – – Revelation 16:3 - The second angel poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became like the blood of a corpse, and every living thing died that was in the sea.	
C. The Third Bowl – – <b>Revelation 16:4</b> - The third angel poured out his bowl into the rivers and the springs of water, and they became blood.	
D. The Fourth Bowl — — Revelation 16:8-9 - The fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and it was allowed to scorch people with fire. <sup>9</sup> They were scorched by the fierce heat, and they cursed the name of God who had power over these plagues. They did not repent and give him glory.	
E. The Fifth Bowl – – Revelation 16:10 –11 - The fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness. People gnawed their tongues in anguish 11 and cursed the God of heaven for their pain and sores. They did not repent of their deeds.
