

1. \_\_\_\_\_ the prophet was - **Jeremiah 1:1–3**

a. \_\_\_\_\_ – **Jeremiah 1:1a** - *The words of Jeremiah, the son of Hilkiyah.*

- **2 Kings 23:4** - *And the king commanded Hilkiyah the high priest and the priests of the second order and the keepers of the threshold to bring out of the temple of the LORD .....*

**Jeremiah 1:1b** - .....one of the priests ....

b. \_\_\_\_\_ – **Jeremiah 1:1c** - *“Who were in Anathoth in the land of Benjamin.”*

c. \_\_\_\_\_ – **Jeremiah 1:2a** - *“To whom the word of the LORD came”*

a. **Jeremiah 1:2b** - *“In the days of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah, in the thirteenth year of his reign...”*

**2 Chronicles 34:1–2** - *Josiah was eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty-one years in Jerusalem. <sup>2</sup> And he did what was right in the eyes of the LORD, and walked in the ways of David his father; and he did not turn aside to the right hand or to the left.*

b. **Jeremiah 1:3a**– *“It came also in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah.”*

**2 Chronicles 36:5** – *“Jehoiakim was twenty-five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. He did what was evil in the sight of the Lord his God.”*

c. **Jeremiah 1:3b** – *“And until the end of the eleventh year of Zedekiah, the son of Josiah, king of Judah, until the captivity of Jerusalem in the fifth month.”*

**2 Chronicles 36:11–12** - *Zedekiah was twenty-one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. <sup>12</sup> He did what was evil in the sight of the LORD his God. He did not humble himself before Jeremiah the prophet, who spoke from the mouth of the Lord.*

2. \_\_\_\_\_ the prophet was – **Jeremiah 1:4-10**

1. The prophet was one who was \_\_\_\_\_ by the LORD for a purpose - **Jeremiah 1:4–5** - *Now the word of the Lord came to me, saying, <sup>5</sup> “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.”*

2. The prophet was one who was \_\_\_\_\_ by the LORD for a purpose - **Jeremiah 1:6–10** - <sup>6</sup> *Then I said, “Ah, LORD God! Behold, I do not know how to speak, for I am only a youth.” <sup>7</sup> But the LORD said to me, “Do not say, ‘I am only a youth’; for to all to whom I send you, you shall go, and whatever I command you, you shall speak. <sup>8</sup> Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, declares the LORD.” <sup>9</sup> Then the LORD put out his hand and touched my mouth. And the LORD said to me, “Behold, I have put my words in your mouth. <sup>10</sup> See, I have set you this day over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to break down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant.”*

3. \_\_\_\_\_ the prophet was – **Jeremiah 1:11-17**

a. The LORD is going to \_\_\_\_\_ His word – **Jeremiah 11:11-12** - *And the word of the LORD came to me, saying, “Jeremiah, what do you see?” And I said, “I see an almond branch.” <sup>12</sup> Then the Lord said to me, “You have seen well, for I am watching over my word to perform it.”*

b. The LORD is sending \_\_\_\_\_ from the north – **Jeremiah 1:13-15**- *The word of the LORD came to me a second time, saying, “What do you see?” And I said, “I see a boiling pot, facing away from the north.” <sup>14</sup> Then the LORD said to me, “Out of the north disaster shall be let loose upon all the inhabitants of the land. <sup>15</sup> For behold, I am calling all the tribes of the kingdoms of the north, declares the LORD, and they shall come, and every one shall set his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, against all its walls all around and against all the cities of Judah.*

c. The LORD is \_\_\_\_\_ His judgements – **Jeremiah 1:16-17** - *And I will declare my judgments against them, for all their evil in forsaking me. They have made offerings to other gods and worshiped the works of their own hands. <sup>17</sup> But you, dress yourself for work; arise, and say to them everything that I command you. Do not be dismayed by them, lest I dismay you before them.*
