A. He possesses the \_\_\_\_\_ of the King

**Matthew 1:2-6 & 16** - Abraham was the father of Isaac, and Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers, <sup>3</sup> and Judah the father of Perez and Zerah by Tamar, and Perez the father of Hezron, and Hezron the father of Ram, <sup>4</sup> and Ram the father of Amminadab, and Amminadab the father of Nahshon, and Nahshon the father of Salmon, <sup>5</sup> and Salmon the father of Boaz by Rahab, and Boaz the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse, <sup>6</sup> and Jesse the father of David the king. And David was the father of Solomon by the wife of Uriah...<sup>16</sup> and Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ.

B. He fulfills the \_\_\_\_\_ about the King

1. He comes from the promised \_\_\_\_\_ of Israel – **Genesis 12:2-3** - And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. <sup>3</sup> I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

2. He comes out of the promised \_\_\_\_\_ of Judah - **Genesis 49:10** -The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

3. He comes with the promised \_\_\_\_\_ – **Numbers 24:17** - I see him, but not now; I behold him, but not near: a star shall come out of Jacob, and a scepter shall rise out of Israel; it shall crush the forehead of Moab and break down all the sons of Sheth.

4. He comes through the promised \_\_\_\_\_ of King David – **Jeremiah 23:5** “Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.

5. He comes through the promised \_\_\_\_\_ of the Virgin Birth – **Isaiah 7:13–14** - And he said, “Hear then, O house of David! Is it too little for you to weary men, that you weary my God also? <sup>14</sup> Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

6. He comes to the promised \_\_\_\_\_ of Bethlehem – **Micah 5:2** - But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.

7. He comes at the promised \_\_\_\_\_ of the Messiah - **Daniel 9:25** - Know therefore and understand that from the going out of the word to restore and build Jerusalem to the coming of an anointed one, a prince, there shall be seven weeks. Then for sixty-two weeks it shall be built again with squares and moat, but in a troubled time.

C. He gives the \_\_\_\_\_ of a King – **Matthew 5-7**

1. His \_\_\_\_\_ - **Matthew 5:1–2** - Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him. <sup>2</sup> And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying.....

2. His \_\_\_\_\_ – **Matthew 7:28-29** - And when Jesus finished these sayings, the crowds were astonished at his teaching, <sup>29</sup> for he was teaching them as one who had authority, and not as their scribes.

D. He follows the \_\_\_\_\_ of a King

1. The Old Testament \_\_\_\_\_ - **Zechariah 9:9** - *Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.*

2. The New Testament \_\_\_\_\_ - **Matthew 21:1, 4-5** - *Now when they drew near to Jerusalem and came to Bethphage, to the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples...<sup>4</sup> This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying, <sup>5</sup> "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your king is coming to you, humble, and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.' "*

E. He has the \_\_\_\_\_ of a King

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of His power - **Matthew 28:18** - *And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me."*

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of His power - **Matthew 28:19-20** - *"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."*

So...What's it to me - What should be our response to this King?

**Matthew 2:10-11** - *When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy. <sup>11</sup> And going into the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh.*
