The _____ of the Gentiles without Christ – **Ephesians 4:17b-19** - *In the futility of their minds.* ¹⁸ *They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart.* ¹⁹ *They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity.*

a. In Fruitlessness – “...*in the futility of their minds.*”

b. In Darkness - “*They are darkened in their understanding...*”

c. In Alienation – “..... *alienated from the life of God...*”

d. In Ignorance - “.....*because of the ignorance that is in them...*”

e. In Hardness – “.... *due to their hardness of heart...They have become callous....*”

f. . In Enslavement – “.... *and have given themselves up to sensuality....*”

- *Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, ²⁷ and give no opportunity to the devil.*

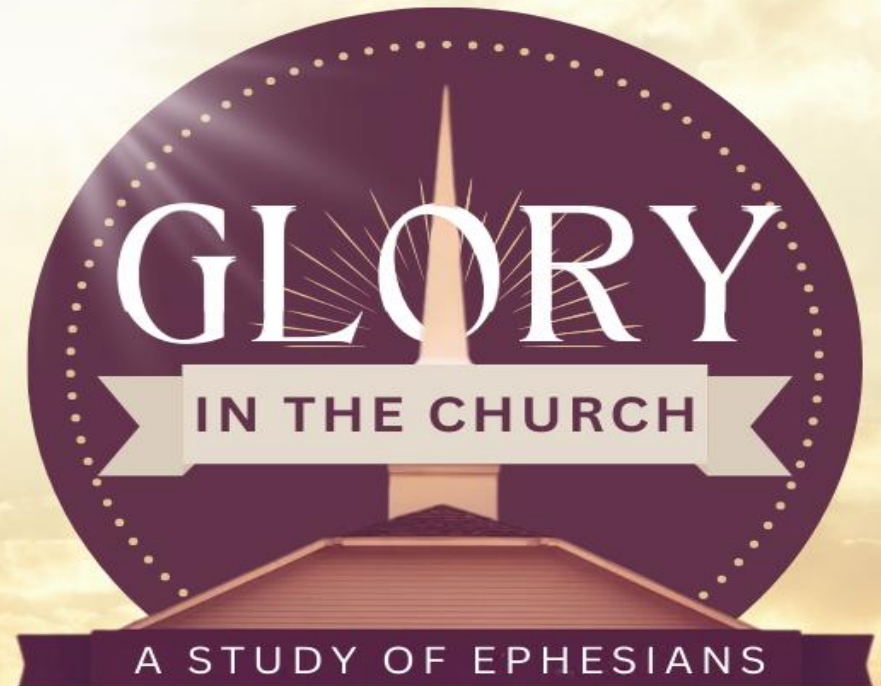

Put off _____ and put on _____ - ***Ephesians 4:30–32*** - *And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ³¹ Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. ³² Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.*
