What is its This is not speaking of our own righteousness - <i>Isaiah 64:6</i> It is speaking about imputed righteousness that we have been given "in Christ" as seen in <i>Romans 4:6</i> and <i>2 Corinthians 5:21</i> is in view. It also involves imparted righteousness seen in <i>Romans 6:13</i> and <i>14:17</i>
- The evil one accuses us continually (<i>Revelation 12:10</i>) but in Christ we face no condemnation (<i>Romans 8:31-34</i>).
