- With effort I seek to meet with God

4. There was _____ on my part – **Psalm 63:1c** - *My soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.*

- I was like a person seeking water in the desert – **Psalm 130:6**

5. There was _____ on my part – **Psalm 63:2** - *So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.*

- I went to the last place I saw God to look for Him again. – **Psalm 27:4**

6. There was _____ on my part - **Psalm 63:3** - *Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.*

- God’s loyal love Hebrew - “hesed”) is better than life itself so I had to seek Him and laud Him.

7. There was _____ on my part – **Psalm 63:4** - *So I will bless you as long as I live; in your name I will lift up my hands*

- I lifted up my hands and cupped them asking God to fill me with Himself – **1 Timothy 2:8**

1. My soul is _____ as it is filled with thoughts of God – **Psalm 63:5--6**- *My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips, ⁶ when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night.*

a. Satisfied = to have one’s fill

b. Marrow and fatness = A feast on rich food

c. Spill’s over to the mouth in praise = Hebrew “hallel” – a full throated hallelujah

d. Joyful lips from a joyous heart regardless

e. Remember = to think of, Mediate = tmutter about over and over

f. Shepherd Days, Goliath Days, Saul Days, King Days

h. Three night watches of four hours each - See **Psalm 119:148**

2. My soul is _____ as it is filled with thoughts about God – **Psalm 63:7** - *For you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy.*

- **Psalm 46:1** – God’s help
- Shadow of your wings – a place of safety – **Psalm 57:1 & 91:1**
- Rejoice = Sing for joy

3. My soul is _____ as it is filled with thoughts about God – **Psalm 63:8** - *My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.*

- Follow close behind = to cling, to cleave, to capture by pursuing, to overtake (Heb. “dabaq”) – **Deuteronomy 10:20**
- I cling to You but really you’re holding on to me – **Isaiah 41:10**

1. I possess _____ (enemies) – **Psalm 63:9a** - *But those who seek to destroy my life...*

- Remember David is being chased even as he chases after God
- His enemies want Him dead - See **1 Peter 5:8** and **John 10:10**


2. I possess _____ (faith) – **Psalm 63:9b-10** - *“...shall go down into the depths of the earth; 10 they shall be given over to the power of the sword; they shall be a portion for jackals.*

- Speaks of an early death – **2 Samuel 18:32**
- Violent death – **2 Samuel 18:14-15**
- Undignified death – **2 Samuel 18:17**

3. I possess _____ (but) – **Psalm 63:11** - *But the king shall rejoice in God; all who swear by him shall exult, for the mouths of liars will be stopped.*

- In contrast to the losers above, King David will win and so will those with him.
