A. What have we not drawn near to? – **Hebrews 12:18a** –
“For you have not come to...”

1. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:18b** - *What may be touched, a blazing fire and darkness and gloom and a tempest...*

2. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:19** - *And the sound of a trumpet and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that no further messages be spoken to them.*

3. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:20-21**- *For they could not endure the order that was given, “If even a beast touches the mountain, it shall be stoned.”²¹ Indeed, so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, “I tremble with fear.”*

B. What have we drawn near to? – **Hebrews 12:22a** - “But you have come to...”

1. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:22b** - *....Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem...*

2. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:22c-23a** - *...and to innumerable angels in festal gathering²³ and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven...*

3. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:23b** - *.... and to God, the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect...*

4. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:24** - *...and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.*

5. The _____ - **Hebrews 12:25 -27** - *See that you do not refuse him who is speaking. For if they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape if we reject him who warns from heaven.²⁶ At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, “Yet once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.”²⁷ This phrase, “Yet once more,” indicates the removal of things that are shaken—that is, things that have been made—in order that the things that cannot be shaken may remain.*

C. What do we need to do about it? – **Hebrews 12:28a** –

1. Let us be _____ purposely – **Hebrews 12:28b** –
“...let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be
shaken....”

2. Let us _____ acceptably – **Hebrews 12:28c-29** -
